INTRODUCTION / PREAMBLE

By Regulation (EU) 2016/679, containing provisions for the protection of individuals regarding the processing of personal data, Conservatorio di Musica "Giuseppe Verdi" with headquarters in Via Conservatorio, 12 – 20122 Milano (hereinafter called the "Organization") as a data controller, it is required to provide certain information regarding the use of personal data. The representative of the Data Controller is the President at the time appointed.

This is without prejudice compliance by the organization of the existing rules on transparency and mandatory publication of data and documents.

DATA SOURCES AND TYPOLOGY OF PROCESSED DATA

The personal data of students/users acquired by the organization can be collected:

- directly from the data subject (for example at the time of an entry or at the time of a request for a specific service, also through online services)
- · at public-access sources
- at/with third parties in the event where any organization acquires data for the purpose of using them for the pursuit of the institutional purposes (for example
 in public administration in the event of a request for official certificates)

For data collected not directly from the data subject, this disclaimer is provided upon registration and no later than the first communication.



The processed data, where the relationship in place so requests, include: personal details and specific information such as sensitive / judicial data. It may be that within the institutional framework of the teaching and enrollment management / students' careers, the organization has to deal with such data related to students and / or families with disabilities for the purpose of any check on self-certification on Fees and the contributions from students and possible exemptions from the payment of the same and / or use of any facilities provided by law, as well as data on the management of extraordinary contributions to student initiatives; data revealing the political or religious beliefs or ethnic origin that may come out in relation to refugee status for the use of waivers and scholarships; Data relating to the protection of motherhood for the enjoyment of any benefits and legal benefits; sensitive and judicial data that detect within the framework of disciplinary procedures for students; data related to the condition of the disabled for interpreting activities, tutoring, transport and similar services that may be required by disabled students.

In any case, all data are treated in the pursuit of the institutional in compliance with the above Act and the privacy obligations that have always guided the organization's operations.

PERIOD OF DATA STORAGE



The data is stored only for the period necessary for the purposes for which they are processed, or in the terms provided for by laws, national and EU rules and regulations to which the organization has to follow (eg. As accounting or tax laws, etc.).

Periodic checks are expected to be carried out on the processed data and the possibility of being able to delete if no longer needed for their intended purposes.

DATA CONFERMENT AND CONSEQUENCES OF NOT PROVIDING / MISSED PROVIDING

MANDATORY/ NOT MANDATORY



The provision of data to be considered mandatory for what concerns the treatment that the organization must do to meet its institutional obligations towards the party concerned on the basis of the relationship, as well as legal obligations, rules, regulations. Failure to provide such data will make it impossible for the organization to act on the existing relationship or to provide the requested service.

The purposes for which it is mandatory to provide the data is marked with the following symbol:



The consent is not required for any other purpose and, even when given, may be revoked at any time by the person concerned.

PURPOSE OF DATA PROCESSING



The data is processed in the normal activities of the organization and for the following institutional purposes:

Provision of education services required under the existing relationship (teaching and management of entries / careers): for example, register for classes, exams, the activities of interest, organization and management of teaching, organization and communication of initiatives (such as concerts, educational and artistic projects, master classes, seminars, etc.) and all the purposes of legitimate interest or related administrative duties, accounting and tax effected for purposes of public institutional, data communication to the MIUR Ministry and / or other entities for statistical purposes, retention of data for purposes of establishment of a institutional historical archive, implementation and management of obligations under applicable laws, regulations and national and Community legislation, and provisions issued by authorities legitimated by law and by the vigilance and control (eg. safety aspects, etc).



The data may be subject to possible treatment anonymously for conducting statistical activities aiming at developing the institutional and / or improvement of the services and / or the detection of the degree of student satisfaction on the activities performed by the organization performed by internal bodies following the procedures laid down by the evaluation team (internal organ and governed by. 10 of Presidential Decree 132/03) for example by online survey.

Any sensitive and judicial data as part of the teaching and enrollment management / students' careers can be processed for the purpose of overriding public interest: concession, liquidation, modification and revocation of economic benefits, qualifications; assistance, social integration and rights of disabled persons; education and training in schools, vocational, higher or university.



Management of any litigation, court and / or consultancy activities. In this context, any sensitive and legal data can be used for the following purposes in the substantial public interest: application of the rules on administrative sanctions and appeals; enforce the right of defense in administrative or judicial; verification of the legality, of good performance, the impartiality of the administration, as well as the compliance of such activities to the requirements of rationality, economy, efficiency and effectiveness for which however, entrusted by law to public functions of control subjects, striker and inspection in relation to other subjects.



Any transfer / data communication abroad in countries within the European Union and in countries outside the European Union for the purposes related to the management of transfers of students and exchanges between education institutions (eg in the context of the program Erasmus, or by virtue of inter-institutional agreements, etc)



Any institutional communications, to pursuit the purposes explicited in the Statute, made via text / photo / audio / video material on electronic media (eg. via internet) or traditional media regarding the managed activities / initiatives by the organization that may contain data and images / video / audio containing the person concerned explicitly collected for example also by means of interviews, narration of case studies, events, etc;



Further communication of data public entities, private individuals or groups who request aimed orientation working, training, vocational integration (eg through job offers) and / or the performance of activities, competitions, auditions, etc in the music sector;

DATA PROCESSING MODALITIES



The processing of personal data takes place through manual, computer and telematic tools with logic strictly related to the purposes and in any event so as to ensure the security and confidentiality of the data. The filing of the documentation is done both electronically and on paper. Here is some essential information.






SCOPE OF DISSEMINATION AND CATEGORIES OF PEOPLE



Personal data will be known and processed, in accordance with current legislation, by the institution's staff, identified as in charge, in service at the relevant facilities. The personal data collected by the organization may be communicated, for the pertinent to the aforementioned purposes, also to the following subjects or categories of subjects:





- Public, private or associations who request aimed orientation working, training, vocational integration (eg through job offers) and / or the performance of activities, competitions, auditions, etc in the music industry also abroad;
- Third parties who work with the organization in order to provide educational / artistic service requested (for example: Music Masters, orchestras, music associations, foundations, etc)
- All subjects any recipients of the organization's communication campaigns (for the purpose n.4)

MAIN LEGAL SOURCES



The data are used for the development of the institutional aims of the terms laid down in laws, regulations and national and EU regulations that the organization should follow. According to Regulation (EU) 2016/679, explicit normative references updated to their latest review state involving obligations or tasks on which could be possibly carried out the treatment of sensitive and judicial data, are available from the Data Controller, represented by the President at the time appointed. Such data may be disclosed as part of the pursuit of the intended purposes, only where required by law or regulation. It is without prejudice the communication or dissemination of data requested, in accordance with the law, police forces, judicial authorities, intelligence and security agencies or other public bodies, for purposes of defense or state security or the prevention, detection or suppression of crime.

DATA SUBJECT'S RIGHT



At any time the data subject could exercise his rights against the data controller or data processor in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 by contacting the owner using the following contacts: privacy@consmilano.it — Conservatorio di Musica "Giuseppe Verdi" Via Conservatorio, 12 20122 - Milano (for written communications), represented by the President at the time appointed. To ensure the proper exercise of the rights, the person must make themselves identifiable unequivocally. The organization is committed to providing feedback within 30 days and, in case of impossibility to respect these times, to justify any extension of the deadline. The feedback will be free of charge except in cases of unfounded (eg. There are no data concerning the applicant concerned) or excessive demands (ie. Repetitive over time) which may be charged a fee not exceeding the actual costs incurred for the research conducted in this case. The rights referring to personal data concerning deceased persons may be exercised by those who have a personal or acts to protect or for family reasons deserving protection. The data subject has the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.

RIGHT TO GET ALL OF

- origin of the personal data
- categories of processed data
- \bullet the purposes and methods of treatment
- retention period
- the logic applied in case of processing with the aid of electronic instruments
- identity of the data controller, data processor
- subjects and categories of subjects to whom the personal data can be communicated or who can learn about them as managers or in charge even in Third Countries
- existence of the profiling process

• existence or otherwise of their personal data and that such data are made available in an intelligible form

RIGHT TO OBTAIN

- updating, correction or integration of data and limitation
- •cancellation, anonymization or blocking of data processed in violation of the law (including those for which conservation is not necessary for the purposes for which it was collected and subsequently processed)
- confirmation that the transactions referred to in paragraphs above have been made known even to those to whom the data were communicated or disclosed, except where such compliance is impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate to the protected right by the organization
- a copy of the processed data

RIGHT TO OPPOSE

- the processing of personal data concerning the data subject including profiling for legitimate reasons, even if pertinent to the purpose of collection
- the processing of personal data concerning him for the purpose of: sending advertising material, direct sale, conducting market research, commercial communications
- the processing of data processed for the purposes of historical or scientific research or statistical purposes except in cases of public interest in the treatment
